Truxton Town Board Meeting Minutes July 18, 2018 7:00 p.m.

CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

Truxton Town Board Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Lloyd Sutton, Jr. at the Truxton Town Office, Historic Train Depot, on July 18th, 2018 at 7:02 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion to approve the June 20th minutes was made by Gus Wehbe. Second by PJ Dwyer. All in favor.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR

John Kinneally brought to the attention of the Board that he has come across 3 separate residents in town who have been burning rubbish. He stated he called the 911 center to report the fires to which the TFD arrived to the fires and a member of the TFD told the resident who reported it and John has since been harassed. He also called the DEC who ticketed one of the residents and has filed a report with the State Troopers about the harassment. He requested the Board post on website and a few local businesses a list of what can and cannot be burned in town. Lloyd stated he would be able to do that.

CONTRACT RENEWAL OF BOOKKEEPING/PAYROLL

Yearly cost of \$830.00 is due to renew the Williamson payroll software. Motion to approve contract was made by PJ Dwyer. Second motion was made by Carlton Young. All in favor.

DISCUSSION ON UPKEEP OF JOHN J MCGRAW FIELD, TENNIS COURT AND GRANDSTAND

The Board would like to see the tennis courts redone (resurfaced, repainted, reset tennis posts, cut posts to 8', add vinyl fencing). Upkeep on the Grandstand would consist of replacing the benches with standard hardwood. The Board did not think the baseball field needed to be redone. Also, Lloyd would like to meet with Jeff Reakes, Superintendent to see what updates are needed at the Town Garage.

WORKERS COMP/SALESTAX UPDATE

Lloyd updated the Board on the costs of the previous years Workers Comp plan and projected for 2019. The Board discussed (possibly) pulling out of the County Plan and opening up their own Workers Comp plan with Comp Alliance. The Board requested to see the numbers and costs before deciding but overall seemed to think it would be a better plan. Deadline to decide is July 31. Lloyd is going to get numbers and if its comparable in cost, will hold an emergency meeting Wednesday July 25, 2018 to discuss with the Board.

PAYMENT OF THE BILLS/SUPERVISORS REPORT

Bills were reviewed by Board members and signed. Motion to approve Highway bills was made by Gus Wehbe. Second Motion was made by Carlton Young. All in Favor. Motion to approve General bills was made by Carlton Young. Second Motion was made by PJ Dwyer. All in favor.

MISC.

Lloyd informed the Board the town has received 2 Mortgage Releases for the HUDD grants that were given out back in 2004.

The Town Justice has requested to have \$200 petty cash to have on hand for change when fines are paid. The Board agreed.

Lloyd stated the town should look into updating their street lights to LED.
