Truxton Town Board Meeting Minutes November 21, 2018 7:00 p.m.

CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

Truxton Town Board Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Lloyd Sutton, Jr. at the Truxton Town Office, Historic Train Depot, on November 21, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion to approve October's minutes with percent of salary increase was made by Molly McDermott. Second motion was made by PJ Dwyer. All in favor.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT JOB OPENING

Jeff Reakes, Highway Superintendent offered the position of Highway Employee to applicant who turned down the position. Jeff and the Board then interviewed another applicant who lives in the Town of Truxton, has experience and is very eager to become the new Employee of Truxton. Gus Wehbe made the motion to hire at the pay rate of \$18.50/hr with 3 days of PTO until 12/31/18, when the employee manual listed PTO will start. Second motion was made by PJ Dwyer. All in favor.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR

PJ Dwyer called for an Executive Session to discuss Employee Evaluation. (7:10p – 7:36p)

After discussion, the Board agreed to increase the pay of certain Highway Employee pay from \$19.87/hr to \$20.00/hr for the 2019 Budget. Motion made by PJ Dwyer. Second motion made by Carlton Young. All in favor.

Gus Wehbe asked the Board if the language in the employee manual could be adjusted to also read "Elected Official" with Employee in regards to their Insurance Policy. The Board agreed at a later date.

Lloyd Sutton stated he wanted to revisit the Town's Procurement Policy and look into training for the Highway Employees in the first quarter of 2019.

The Town Clerk received a 'stopped payment' notice for a tax bill. The town is now responsible to contact homeowner and resolve issue.

Transfer Station tags are due to be ordered. The Board agreed on ordering 430 tags in maroon with white print.

Gus Wehbe informed the Board that Truxton did not get the funding for Robbins Road however he is looking into other ways to rebuild and move forward.

Lloyd Sutton stated the Justice has not found a qualified person to fill the Court Security position. Still looking at possibilities.

PAYMENT OF THE BILLS/SUPERVISORS REPORT

The monthly bills were passed around to the board. The highway bills were approved by PJ Dwyer. Second motion was made by Molly McDermott. Motion to approve the general bills was made by Gus Whebe. Second motion was made by Carlton Young. All in favor.
