## **Truxton Town Board Meeting Minutes July 17, 2019 7:00 p.m.**

### **CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.**

Truxton Town Board Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Lloyd Sutton, Jr. at the Truxton Town Office, Historic Train Depot, on July 17, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

### **WORKERS COMPENSATION SELF INSURANCE/COMP ALLIANCE**

Lloyd Sutton stated that he, Carlton Young, Paul Heider and both Fire Commissioners have been attending Cortland County's Workers Comp meetings. After the County's meeting in June, the City of Cortland has passed a resolution to dissolve their contract with Cortland County's Self Insurance Plan. Lloyd did mention that he heard that the County stated that there is a separate plan that covers catastrophic events for firemen and firewomen. Molly McDermott asked for clarification on the catastrophic plan, Lloyd stated that the plan stands at \$1500/yr, Comp Alliance fireman / firewomen stands at \$11,000/yr. Paul Heider stated to keep in mind that the more Towns that opt out, taxpayers' amount will increase. Jim Greggains asked for clarification on totals for each plan; County Self-Insurance \$13,000 (and will increase with each town that opts out), Comp Alliance \$21,000.

Motion to authorize supervisor to send letter to Cortland County to opt out of Cortland County Self-Insurance Plan for 2020 was made by Lloyd Sutton, Jr. Second motion was made by Gus Wehbe. All in favor.

Lloyd Sutton stated he asked Don Armstrong, Town Attorney, to write letter to ask for funds that are left in the Truxton's account.

Town Clerk to write and seal Resolution.

### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

### **PAYROLL SOFTWARE CONTRACT**

Lloyd Sutton stated it is time to reappoint the assessor. Will be on August agenda.

Gus Wehbe stated the Town needs to hire a crossing guard for the Charter School. Nominates Jane Ryan. Will be on August agenda.

Gus Whebe asked to look into ways to keep pigeons out from under the pavilion roof. Discussing options and other Depot renovations on August agenda.

Procurement Policy for August Agenda.

Justice Sutton brought it to the Board attention that he is hiring Rita Dawson and Eileen Foley for the Trial held at the Truxton Depot 7/31/19, 8/1/19. Also asked for the Boards approval to offer a catered lunch for jurors. The Board agreed.
