Truxton Town Board Meeting Minutes November 20, 2019 7:00 p.m.

CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

Truxton Town Board Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Lloyd Sutton, Jr. at the Truxton Town Office, Historic Train Depot, on November 20, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion to approve October meeting minutes with changes was made by PJ Dwyer. Second motion was made by Molly McDermott. All in favor.

REVIEW LOCAL LAW FOR LARGE SOLAR SCALE PROJECTS

Lloyd Sutton mentioned that the Representative was not able to attend monthly meeting. Also informed the Board that Don is waiting on approval to move forward with PILOT agreement. Board agreed to move forward. Gus Wehbe mentioned that he wants correct wording that Residential Solar Energy Systems be exempt. The Board agreed on a 25MW threshold. Also the Board wants correct wording if homeowners do not manage the panels. Carlton Young mentioned that Solar Collectors are not to be on Soil Maps.

CROSSING GUARD

As of Nov 13, 2019, the Charter school allowed drop offs to happen in parking lot rather than the road. Motion to dissolve crossing guard position on December 20, 2019 based on changes in traffic pattern at the Truxton Charter School drop off location was made by PJ Dwyer. Second motion made by Carlton Young. All in favor.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

Lloyd Sutton had received a message asking is Kettlebail Road was plowed and it is not. Looking into options for homeowner.

Jeff Reakes, Highway Superintendent, had the Transfer Station truck towed to Utica area to be worked on. Gus Wehbe provided the Board with a handout explaining the Transfer Station Reserve fund. Revisit at a later date.

Lloyd Sutton informed the Board that overtime for the Highway Department has been used quite often on jobs that could have been waited on or postponed. Also, that the Highway Superintendent is not signing time sheets of highway employees, which could affect an audit. Lloyd stated that planned overtime needs to be examined and Gus mentioned he would like to examine the employee manual at organizational meeting regarding overtime.

Lloyd Sutton also mentioned that fuel at the highway garage needs to be monitored more closely. Revisit at a later date.
